### STAGE MOM/VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP – BEGINS APRIL 3RD

During each recital performance, we need wonderful volunteers to help supervise classes, and assist classes to get to and from the stage. **We will post the stage mom sign-up sheet on the bulletin board across from the main studio office on April 3rd at 4:00 PM.** Stage moms will not need a recital ticket for the performance(s) they are helping with. Stage moms will need to be sure they can commit to a show before signing up.

## **RECITAL T-SHIRTS: DEADLINE – APRIL 14<sup>TH</sup>**

Recital t-shirts featuring this year's design can be ordered using the forms sent to your email. You can also order online through your parent portal account or using the IMDS app. Extra order forms can be found in the office. Orders will be accepted through April 14<sup>th</sup>, with payment made in full. The cost of each t-shirt is \$15.00 (\$2 extra for 2XL, \$3 for 3XL, \$4 for 4XL). Recital shirts will be handed out May 15-20, at your child's class. (Design on front of shirt only)

## **SOUVENIR RECITAL PROGRAMS: PRE-ORDER DEADLINE – APRIL 27<sup>TH</sup>**

Souvenir recital programs will be available again this year and is a great keepsake for years to come. The program is in full color and will include each class's recital picture, list of student's names by class, 2023 senior bios with Sr pictures, business ads, message ads, acknowledgements, and other memorable information. If you pre-order a program by April 27<sup>th</sup>, the cost per program is \$9. Otherwise we will sell a limited amount of programs in the Ritz lobby for \$10 each (cash or check only), before each show while supplies last. To pre-order a program, see the order form in your email, or order online through your parent portal account by April 27. Extra forms can be found in the office.

- **MESSAGE AD: DEADLINE –APRIL 27TH:** Family members and friends can place message ads in this year's Souvenir program for their special dancer/s. Each ad space is \$15.00, and is approximately 4"x 1". The ad includes the child's individual recital picture, and can fit up to four lines of text. To place a message ad in this year's recital program, please fill out the message ad form that was emailed out, or order online through parent portal. Extra forms can be found in the office. We must receive your form no later than **April 27<sup>th</sup>** to be included in this year's souvenir program.
- **BUSINESS ADS IN PROGRAM: DEADLINE – APRIL 27TH:** Business ads are a great way to advertise your business to all of our recital attendees. A half-page ad in color is \$60.00, and a full-page ad in color is \$100.00. ## **2023 RECITAL DVD: PRE-ORDER DEADLINE - MAY 18TH**

Memories In Motion will be producing our Recital DVDS once again. They will also be offering both dvds and digital downloads, which is convenient! Pre-Orders will be accepted at the studio through May 18. (Forms will be available soon.) You may also order in the Ritz Lobby before each recital performance. DVDs will be available for pickup approximately six-eight weeks following recital. **Checks should be made out to Memories In Motion.**

## **COSTUME ALTERATION DAY - APRIL 20**

Costume alterations will be available on Thursday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, from 4:30- 7:00 pm (in Studio B waiting area) for anyone who needs minor costume alterations done. Please bring in your child's costume, along with your child, to discuss alterations. It is likely that most students will need shoulder strap adjustments; a flat rate of \$5.00 will be charged for strap adjustments. Some adjustments will be done on site, however some adjustments may take longer to complete and cost more. All alterations will be ready by recital picture weekend. Upfront payment of cash or check is required for all alterations.

## **ACCOUNT BALANCES - PAID OFF BY MAY 18TH**

For your child to participate in this year's recital, **any balance due on your studio account must be paid in full by May 18<sup>th</sup>.** Please note that May's tuition is 1/2 of your normal monthly tuition amount (or two lessons less). You may pay with cash/check by May 5<sup>th</sup>, otherwise it will automatically be withdrawn on May 7<sup>th</sup>.

## RECITAL PICTURES: MAY 5-7

Recital pictures will be taken in classroom B on May 5-7 by Unique Images of Ohio. Each class will have a scheduled photo time, during which individual and group pictures will be taken. Students will need to wear their recital costume, tights, and dance shoes. Students should wear their hair as instructed (See Hair instruction sheet). Light make-up is recommended for pictures, but is not required. Picture order forms will be handed out the week before pictures, and students in multiple classes will need to turn in one form for **EACH** different class they are in. Order forms need to be completed and turned in, with full payment, on picture day(s). Checks should be made out to Unique Images of Ohio. Below is the picture schedule. Note that picture times are approximate! Please plan on arriving 5-10 minutes before your child's time slot, and be prepared to stay longer if needed. If you are late, please understand we will NOT be able to wait on your child for the group photo. Also, please have your child dressed and fully prepared for her/his picture to help us and the photographer stay on schedule. If you would like to take personal pictures, you may do so only in the waiting areas. To ensure the photographer can continue to work without distractions, friends and family members are politely asked to remain in the waiting area during pictures. An instructor will escort your child's class into the studio when it is time for his/her pictures.

## INDIVIDUAL CLASS REHEARSALS AT THE RITZ

To better prepare our dancers for the recital and dress rehearsal, each class will first have a 25-30 minute required practice on the Ritz stage. (Dance Teams each 10 min). This practice helps our dancers to become familiar with the stage space, entrances and exits, etc. **Note your child's class rehearsal time is not her/his regular dance class time.** Please make special note of your child's rehearsal time, and remember that we need every student to be at their class rehearsal(s)! Students should come dressed in normal dancewear to class rehearsals, and should arrive 10 minutes prior to their scheduled rehearsal time to warm up. Please see the schedule below and mark your calendars for each of your child's rehearsal days and times. Read the schedule carefully to ensure you attend the correct day and time.

# DRESS REHEARSALS

## May 30-31, JUNE 1

For Dress Rehearsal, students will wear their recital costume, recital tights, dance shoes, and have hair worn as instructed. Make-up is optional for the dress rehearsal. Having the dress rehearsal in full costume helps avoid potential costume mishaps that may occur on stage during the actual recital. The dress rehearsal is also helpful to make adjustments in stage lighting and work out any technical issues before the shows. It is important that every dancer attends their scheduled dress rehearsal.

The dress rehearsals are held at the Ritz Theatre May 30-31 and June 1. See the complete dress rehearsal schedule below, to see when each show will rehearse:

### **Tuesday, May 30<sup>th</sup> Dress Rehearsal:**

**\*Show #1 @ 5:30 – 6:30 pm-** Arrive at 5:15 pm in full costume. We will run the entire show in recital order. All classes within this show should attend. (With exception of the Parent/Child Dance-Their Rehearsal is 7:30-8:00 pm)

**\*Show #4 @ 6:50-7:20 pm -** Arrive at 6:35 pm in full costume (no earlier please). We will rehearse only the classes & dance teams that are NOT also in Show #1. This rehearsal includes the following classes/teams and will rehearse in this order: 1. Pre-Teen Jazz DT / 2. Acro 1B/2A / 3. Tiny Toes 1 Wed / 4. Tiny Toes 2 Wed / 5. Pom Pom Dance / 6. Jr Lyrical DT

\*Parent/Child Dance Rehearsal is 7:30-8:00 pm

### **Wednesday, May 31<sup>st</sup> Dress Rehearsal:**

**\*Show #2 @ 5:30 – 6:30 pm –** Arrive at 5:15 pm in full costume. We will run the entire show in recital order. All classes within this should attend.

**\*Show #5 @ 6:50-7:20 pm –** Arrive at 6:35 pm in full costume (no earlier please). We will rehearse only the classes & dance teams that are NOT also in Show #2. This rehearsal includes the following classes/teams and will rehearse in this order: 1. Acro 1A / 2. Minis DT / 3. Pre-Teen Lyrical DT / 4. Jr Hip Hop / 5. Pre-Jazz Wed / 6. Musical Theatre 1 / 7. Teen Lyrical DT / 8. Ballet 1A Mon

\*Adult Hip Hop Rehearsal is 7:30-8:00 pm

### **Thursday, June 1<sup>st</sup> Dress Rehearsal:**

**\*Show #3 @ 5:30 – 6:30 pm –** Arrive at 5:15 pm in full costume. We will run the entire show in recital order. All classes within this show should attend.

**\*Show #6 @ 6:50-7:20 pm -** Arrive at 6:35 pm in full costume (no earlier please). We will rehearse only the classes & dance teams that are NOT also in Show #3. This rehearsal includes the following classes/teams and will rehearse in this order: 1. Pre-Acro / 2. Tiny Toes 2 Thurs / 3. Pre-Jazz Mon / 4. Ballet 1A/ Tap 1A Thurs / 5. Pre-Ballet Thurs

When you arrive to the Ritz students should locate their class's assigned seating area (see signs on ends of rows) where they will wait until it is time to rehearse on stage. Students in multiple dances should report to their first class (according to the recital order). A stage mom/ instructor will bring your child's class backstage to line up when it is their time. After dancing, dancers will return to their class assigned seats for the remainder of the rehearsal. Students in multiple dances will need to quickly change costumes (in back stage area) and report to their next class's seating area. We will practice the finale at the end of each Dress rehearsal.

### **OTHER IMPORTANT REMINDERS ABOUT THE DRESS REHEARSAL**

1. Only one parent/guardian should arrive with dancer to dress rehearsal. Do not invite additional family members, children, friends, etc.
2. Parents may video or take pictures of their dancer during the dress rehearsal. (Not at recital)
3. Dancers will have access to the dressing rooms as needed to change costumes during each dress rehearsal.
4. Students will need to stay for their entire rehearsal. We will run through the finale at the very end of each dress rehearsal. Once we run the finale, students may leave if not in any additional rehearsals following.
5. During the dress rehearsal, be respectful to those on stage by remaining seated and quiet. Make sure your dancer understands that appropriate behavior is expected during the rehearsal; running up and down the aisles in the theatre will not be permitted.
6. During the dress rehearsal, do not use the parking lots for the Knights of Columbus, Bair Brothers, or Elmwood. If you park in these lots, you may be towed!

## **RECITAL TICKETS**

Recital tickets are purchased online through Dance Recital Ticketing. **Recital tickets go on sale beginning Monday, May 8th at 9:00 AM.** Tickets sales are open to everyone at this time and there are no pre-sales. Just like last year, there will be no limits on how many tickets you can purchase due to the smaller shows and no restrictions on social distancing! As in years past, Graduating Seniors will have first chance to purchase tickets on Thursday, May 4.

To purchase tickets, go to: <http://23466.recitalticketing.com>. You can also go to our website ([inmotiondancstudio.net](http://inmotiondancstudio.net)) and click on the ticketing link to purchase recital tickets. Simply select the show, select your seats, and place them in your virtual shopping cart. **Please carefully check the recital show schedule to ensure you and family/friends are purchasing tickets for the correct performance!** Refunds and/or returns cannot be honored.

If in multiple shows, simply select tickets for first show and place tickets in cart. Then go into each additional show and select seats before checking out. As in previous years, there is a 15 minute time limit to complete your ticket order. The 15 minutes does not begin until you place your tickets in your shopping cart.

Recital tickets are \$12 each. For those purchasing tickets to four or more shows, there is a discount of 10% off that applies after selecting your seats to three shows at regular price. Note the awards show on Sunday night is a flat rate of \$6, and is not part of discount listed previously. The discount will automatically apply to the show/s with the least amount of tickets purchased upon checkout. See example to right: Exp: Show #1 –purchase 4 tix – regular price  
Show #4 – purchase 4 tix- regular price  
Show #2– purchase 3 tix – regular price  
Show #5 – purchase 2 tix – pay 10% off

Once you purchase tickets, you can print off your tickets from your email receipt, and present them at the door recital weekend.

**Ticket Sales will end online June 1, at 8 pm.** At this point, you will no longer be able to purchase recital tickets online (please pass this on to friends and family). Any tickets still available can be purchased in the lobby by In Motion staff/volunteers before each show for \$13/each. We will accept cash/check at the door only. Note the Ritz will not be selling our recital tickets.

## **RECITAL: JUNE 2, 3 & 4**

Our recital weekend includes six performances, and one awards show at the Ritz Theatre held June 2-5. Shows 1 & 2 are held Friday, June 2. Shows 3, 4, & 5 all perform on Saturday, June 3. Show 6 and the Red Carpet Awards show are held on Sunday, June 4. Each show will last approximately 1 hour in length.

Dancers should arrive 20 minutes early, in costume, before each show. Dancers should enter through the far left glass door (when facing the front of the Ritz Theatre) labeled "Dancers Enter Here". Dancers should report to their assigned dressing room (of first dance) and remain with their class until further instructed by a stage mom or instructor. If it is raining, be sure to wear protective clothing over your child's costume to ensure it stays dry.

During the recital, students are expected to stay for the entire show. At no time during the performance, should students sit or mingle with family/friends in the audience. Students should use the restrooms backstage instead of the public restrooms for audience.

At the recital, students will need to wear their hair as instructed (see hair instruction sheet). Please make sure hair is sprayed or gelled well, and use bobby pins to secure any loose hairs. If your child has a hair accessory with her costume, please secure it in tightly using bobby pins. We recommend all dancers wear make-up during the recital, as stage lights wash out skin color. We recommend using foundation (a half shade darker than normal skin color), blush, eye shadow, mascara (not on little ones), eyeliner, lipstick (not pale colors), and bronzer if skin is pale. Apply slightly heavier for stage.

For students with quick costume changes or who may not be comfortable changing in front of others, we recommend wearing a nude color leotard to wear under costumes. Note regular underwear or bras should NOT be worn under costumes as they can be visible on stage. Nude dancer undergarments will be allowed for older students who may need them.



These items can be purchased in the studio office between 4-8 pm, Monday-Thursday through May 18.

Be sure to check your child's dance shoes to make sure they are not too tight! We recommend purchasing these items at least one month before Recital if your child is outgrowing their shoes.

During the recital, we will have volunteers/stage moms in charge of supervising classes backstage. While back stage waiting to dance, students are welcome to bring a quiet game or activity, to help pass the time.

During Recital, we prefer parents/guests do not come back stage. We will allow Moms to come backstage to assist younger children with costume changes (only when necessary). Because of dancers changing costumes throughout recital, only females will be allowed in the dressing room areas backstage.

Students should bring their own water bottle (with secured lid) to help stay hydrated backstage. Be sure to label with your child's name. Since the shows are short we prefer dancers do not bring snacks backstage.

During recital weekend, seating will begin 30 minutes prior to each show. Recital Souvenir programs and DVD's can be purchased in the Ritz lobby before each performance (cash/check only).

### **FOLLOWING RECITAL**

After recital, older level classes (at least age 12-up) will be dismissed from back stage, to meet up with parents on own. Younger aged classes will be escorted by staff, from back stage area, to meet up with a parent on each side of theatre (in front) following recital. We kindly ask that our audience and dancers exit immediately after each show to allow for cleanings and prep work before next show.

### **RED CARPET AWARDS SHOW**

Our special Red Carpet Awards Show will conclude Recital weekend. The Awards show will take place on Sunday, June 4<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 pm and during the event we will recognize 2023 graduating seniors, 10 and 15 year students, 2023 Dance Team Members, staff/assistants, and special student awards. We invite our awards recipients to dress up for this event and be the stars that they are! Last year we had a special drop off event prior to awards, where dancers pulled up to the red carpet in sports cars and fun vehicles only to be greeted by our "studio Paparazzi" for a photo opp. We are excited to bring the event back and recognize this year's recipients. Our graduating seniors will also be performing their senior dance for the very last time as a special farewell. Tickets to the Awards show are a flat rate of \$6 each and can be purchased through Dance Recital Ticketing.

### **OTHER HELPFUL TIPS & REMINDERS FOR RECITAL**

1. During Recital performances, the use of any device to video, or take pictures is not allowed.
2. Please label all dance shoes, tights, costumes and accessories with your child's initials.
3. Please be sure your child uses the restroom before recital.
4. Please double-tie tap/ hip hop shoes. Tuck ballet strings into shoes before recital.
5. Students should bring a quiet game or activity while waiting in the dressing rooms.
6. Make sure all hair accessories are secured in place with bobby pins.
7. Older students should cover up any tattoos, and remove any body piercings. Please avoid un-natural hair color shades (green, blue, pink, etc) leading up to, and through Recital.
8. Dancers should remove jewelry, watches, and earrings for recital.
9. Please be respectful to our staff, volunteers and stage moms who are helping during recital. They have a big job!
10. Dancers, be courteous to others in your dressing room and pick up after yourself.
11. Do not bring large dance bags or rolling suitcases backstage as we do not have room in the dressing rooms!
12. Only enter or exit between dances in the Theatre to avoid blocking the view of others watching. Pass this along to family/friends attending Recital.
13. Remember to print off your tickets to present at the door to ushers.
14. Be sure to give your dancer a big hug after Recital and let them know just how proud you are!!!
